Working languages: English and all Slavic languages

Language of the paper: English only

Papers will be published in the special issue of Slovak scholarly journal Jazykovedný časopis indexed in the databases such as Elsevier – SCOPUS, De Gruyter – IBZ etc.

## **Formal requirements**

Papers will be accepted only in the OpenDocument Text (.odt) format. Full papers should not exceed 13 normalized pages (23 400 characters: spaces and references included). Font type: Times New Roman. Page numbering: None. Proceedings will be printed in black and white/gray scale; no color.

The authors are kindly asked to send their anonymous submissions via <https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=slovko2019> by **March 20, 2019**. Full papers will be reviewed by the programme committee by **May 1, 2019**.

Deadline for camera-ready papers: **August 1, 2019**. Papers cannot be changed after the deadline. Special issue of Jazykovedný časopis will be given to authors at the of conference.
