## **Presentations and full paper submission**

Working languages: English and all Slavic languages

Language of the paper: English only

Accepted papers will be published in the special issue of Slovak scholarly journal **Jazykovedný časopis** indexed in the databases such as **Elsevier – SCOPUS, De Gruyter – IBZ** etc.

The authors are kindly asked to upload their anonymous papers in PDF format via <https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=slovko2021> by **March 22, 2021**. Full papers will be reviewed by the programme committee by **May 1, 2021**.

Deadline for camera-ready papers (in ODT format): **August 1, 2021**. Papers cannot be changed after the deadline.

## **Formal requirements**

Papers will be accepted only in the OpenDocument Text (.odt) format. **Full papers SHOULD NOT exceed 13 normalized pages (23 400 characters: spaces and references included)**. Font type: FreeSerif. Page numbering: None. Proceedings will be printed in black and white/gray scale; no color.

Special issue of **Jazykovedný časopis** will be given to authors at the of conference.
